The Student Advisory Committee to the Dean (SACD) is a committee designed to inform the Dean on student opinions and concerns about College matters. Each Committee member will be charged with commenting on issues the Dean brings before the Committee, as well as providing information for the Dean in a productive manner. This Committee is **not** designed to update the Dean.

The SACD structure will be as follows: The sitting members of the Committee are the LAC Executive Board. The rotating membership on the Committee will be filled by LAC representatives and College of Liberal Arts students at-large. Depending on the major issues at hand, some Committee members may be retained for sequential meetings. These decisions will be made on a case by case basis by SACD Chair Lawson Bishop, in conference with the LAC Executive Board. The Committee will meet once a month with Dean Randy Diehl, Assistant Dean for Development Kathleen Aronson, and CoLA staff as needed in Dean Diehl's office. The Committee will schedule preparatory meetings each month prior to each SACD meeting with the Deans.

The decisions concerning representative involvement with the Committee will be based largely on the interview. Please submit a one page resume to the application, after answering the following questions on a single page at maximum.

1. Why do you feel your presence on the SACD would be beneficial for the Dean, and for the College?
2. Do you have the necessary time management skills to come prepared to the SACD meetings, and how do you plan on establishing yourself as a reliable member of the Committee to the Executive Board?
3. Name 1-2 specific reasons why you want to have your voice heard through the SACD, on behalf of the College student body, in addition to the exposure you will acquire through meeting with the Dean?
