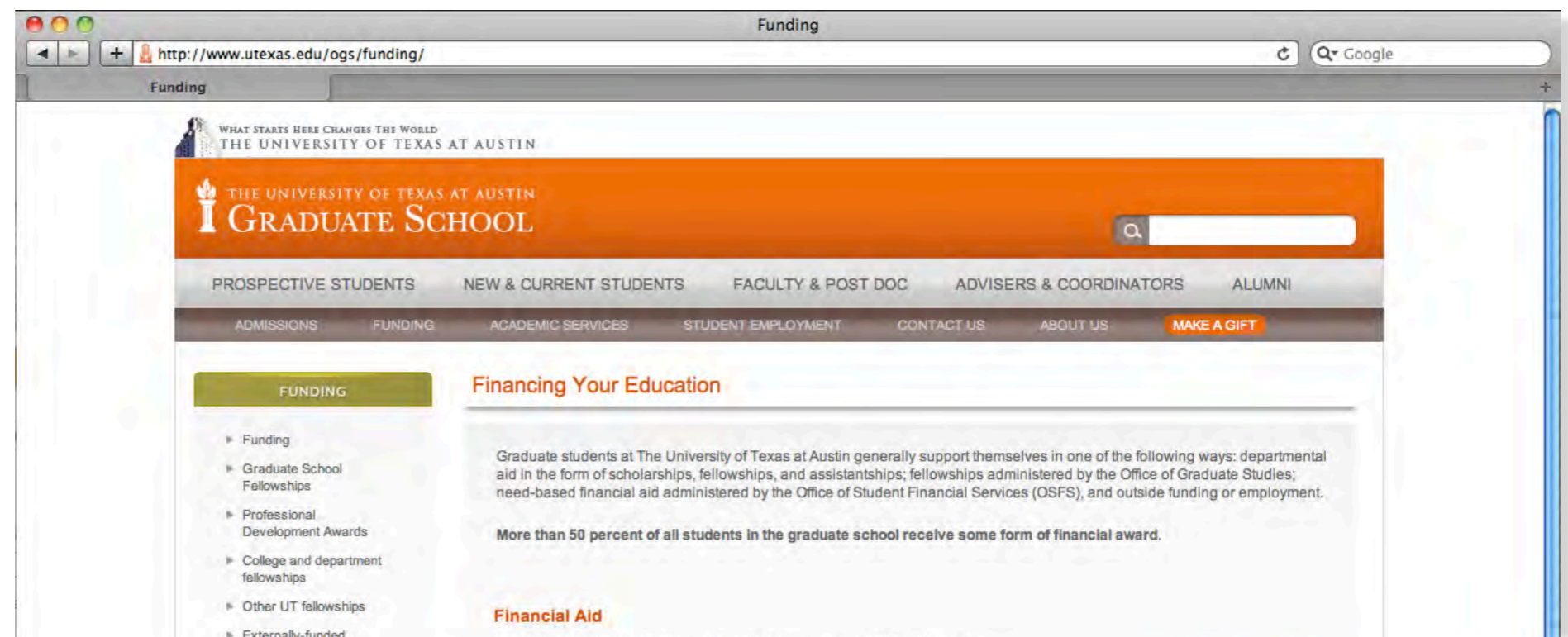

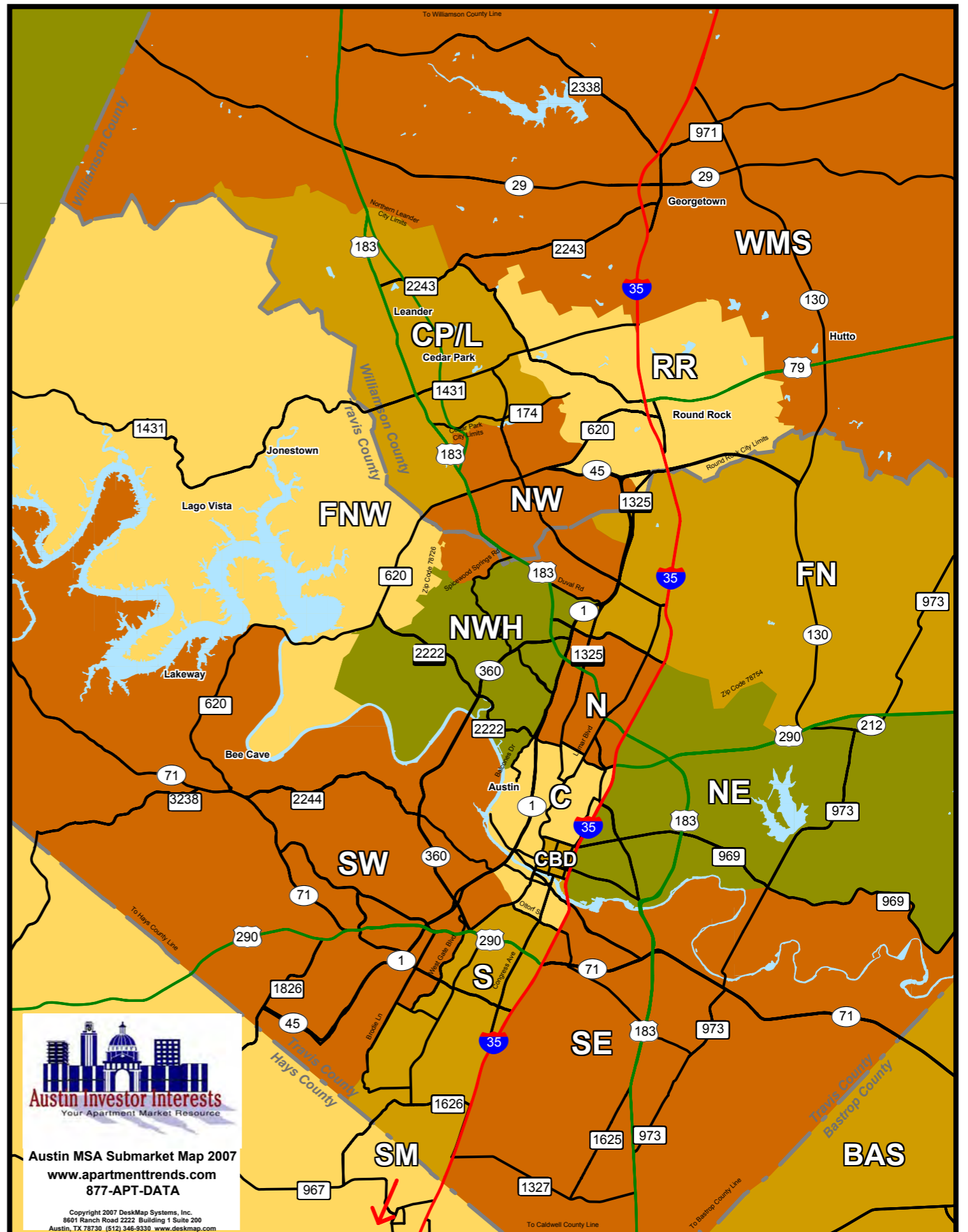

# GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS VS. FELLOWSHIPS

---

## ASSISTANTSHIPS

Provides a monthly stipend **with a service requirement**

Time (**typically 20 hr = “full-time”**)

May include some tuition and **health insurance benefits**

## FELLOWSHIPS

Provides a monthly stipend – **no fixed service requirement**

May include some tuition and **health insurance benefits**

Many sources – Graduate School / College / Dept. / Ext.

Allows much more flexibility

# RESIDENT TUITION ENTITLEMENT

---

You will **still be in a non-resident status.**

The number of non-resident **tuition waivers is limited.**

Each **College and School only get so many.**

# TUITION ASSISTANTSHIP BENEFIT | TAs / AIs

---

## APPOINTMENTS

The Provost's Office provides a **(taxable) Tuition Assistance Benefit (TAB)**

## PAYMENTS

**75%** of the TAB is credited to the tuition bill before payment is due

**25%** remaining, **minus what is required for withholding taxes**, is paid during the pay period around 3<sup>rd</sup> week of September.

# TUITION REMISSION

---

## YOUR DEPARTMENT TO PAY ALL OR PART OF YOUR TUITION

Most commonly used in **Graduate Research Assistant (GRA) title**, but can be used in variety of other titles.

This may be taxable, depending on the position and department.

If the Tuition Remission is part of a federal grant then it will most likely be considered taxable income.

**ASK supervisor about tuition payments when you accept a GRA appointment, do not assume that it will, or will not, just happen!**

# INSURANCE ELIGIBILITY OF GRADUATE STUDENTS

---

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

### STUDENT ACADEMIC TITLE

Graduate students appointed to work in a student academic title for at least 20 hours a week for at least 4.5 months are eligible for the university's employee group insurance benefits.

UT Pays Premium Sharing

### FELLOWSHIP RECEIPT

SB 29, Insurance for Eligibility of Graduate Fellows, was passed in the 2011 legislative session and signed by the Texas governor.

Students must hold in aggregate a "competitive" award or awards of \$10,000 or more per year. The funding date of the fellowship should fall within the fiscal year during which the fellow is eligible to purchase health insurance.

### Non-Employee Graduate Students Assigned as Graduate Student Fellows

SB-29, Insurance Eligibility of Graduate Fellows was passed in the 2011 legislative session and signed by the Texas governor. Sponsored by Senator Judith Zaffirini, Chair of the Senate Higher Education Committee and Representative Dan Branch, Chair of the House Committee on Higher Education, the bill allows graduate students receiving certain fellowships of \$10,000 or more per year to be eligible to participate in UT's group medical insurance plan (i.e., basic medical for the fellow and dependents, including dental and vision insurance). Please note that there is no funding provided to pay the medical premium for the...

# LIFETIME LEARNING CREDIT

---

## NOTE WORTHY

Eligible students who take advantage of the Lifetime Learning Credit on their taxable tuition assistance amount can benefit from up to a \$2,000 credit against your tax bill.

This credit is subtracted from the amount of money you owe the government, instead of reducing the amount of taxable income.
